

# Of Him Are Ye In Christ Jesus

1 Corinthians 1: 30

This declaration gives me four glorious things to contemplate.

First: If it is of the eternal God that I am in Christ Jesus; then there was never a time when I was not in Him. My birth, life and preservation were all considered according to my union with Him.
